## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose is to suspend, stop-out and terminate the Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Studies. The stop-out will allow students currently in the program to complete their course requirements and receive their degrees. Once the stop out has expired, we are requesting to terminate the program.

## **BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with the Board of Regents' policy, Chapter 5, Academic Affairs, Provisional and established programs based on a program review or other internal assessments may be terminated by the president.

In 2005, UH Hilo received provisional approval of a BA in Environmental Studies (BA-ENVS) and a BS in Environmental Sciences (BS-ENSC). After a program review, it was determined that the Department of Geography would make the BA in Environmental Studies a track within the BA in Geography degree. With this admission stop-out and termination the number of degree programs offered by the Department of Geography will be reduced from three to two.

#### ACTION RECOMMENDED:

We recommend that you approve the stop-out and termination of the Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Studies effective Fall 2016 (Stop-out) and Fall 2020 (Termination).
