P.2) Proposal Summary

This is a certificate designed primarily for Art Majors who would like a specialization in Digital Media. Foundation studio classes and Art History are requirements for the B.A. in Art. The B.A. in Art also requires 18 credit hours in studio art beyond the foundation studio classes. So this certificate only requires the two CS classes to be taken outside of the Art Major, one of which counts toward GE.

P.3) Proposal Rationale/Justification

There has been quite a demand for a digital media specialization in our art program, and we have been losing students who transfer to UH Manoa's or West Oahu's Creative Media programs, or even to mainland U.S. art schools. This certificate will allow students to pursue a digital media specialization while majoring in art. It utilizes existing resources on the UH Hilo campus by including two courses from the Computer Science Department. Only one new course is being proposed in conjunction with this certificate, but it has been taught as a special topic in the ART300 Intermediate Studio Seminar course with notable success.
