SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

We request that admission to the Academic Subject Certificate in E-Commerce, Technology and Business (SC-ECTB) at the University of Hawaii at Hilo be stopped out for period of two years beginning with the spring semester of 2016 through the fall 2017 and terminated effective with the Spring 2018 semester.

PURPOSE:

The purpose is to suspend and stop-out the admission and terminate the Academic Subject Certificate program in E-Commerce, Technology and Business under the Computer Sciences department at UH Hilo. This will allow existing students currently completing the program to complete their course requirements and receive their

certificates. Once the stop-out is complete, we are also requesting to terminate the program effective Spring 2018.

BACKGROUND:

UH Executive Policy, E5.205 grants the Chancellor the authority to approve certificate programs in specific subjects that represent recognition of work taken within (or among) existing Board authorized programs.

The Academic Subject Certificate in E-Commerce, Technology and Business was originally approved by the Chancellor in 2002, the program is moving to termination due to the inability to offer the required courses.

We recommend that you approve the stop-out and termination of the Academic Subject Certificate in E-Commerce, Technology and Business effective in Spring 2016 (Stop Out) and Spring 2018 (Termination).
