Aloha Jean,

1) RE: Concentration Code: SPAN already exists in STVMAJR as a major code for Spanish. The code may be used as a concentration code, but the description will need to remain the same - Spanish. Should the campus wish to create a new concentration code with the description, Spanish Language Certificate for Careers, a different 4-digit code will need to be used. Some options that are available: SPNC, SPLC, SLCC. You can check Banner form STVMAJR to see if a code is available. Also, descriptions on STVMAJR is limited to 30 characters including spaces. The description currently being requested will need to be shortened. Recommend using "Spanish Language for Careers" or "Spanish for Careers." I recommend dropping the word certificate so that the code could be used in general for a concentration and not just a certificate.

2) RE: Gainful Employment and Financial Aid: If a certificate is eligible for gainful employment, then the certificate is also financial aid eligible. It is also my understanding that Hilo does not have gainful employment eligible certificates.

3) Program length - in years, decimals okay - is needed.

4) Special program designation is needed. See attachment.
