The home program for this certificate is KES - Kinesiology and Exercise Sciences.

#### P.2) Proposal Summary

The Indigenous Public Health Certificate is a new offering and does not change the program but adds an option for students interested in public health and health sciences. The new certificate is interdisciplinary and collaborative among the departments of KES, Pharmacy, and Sociology and facilitated by Kīpuka - the Native Hawaiian Student Center and in the interest of serving the Hawaii Papa O Ke Ao.

#### P.3) Proposal Rationale/Justification

The new certificate supports both students' growing interest in health related sciences, public health, and indigenous studies. Students attaining this certificate will demonstrate success in coursework that includes an understanding of public health principles, what is meant by an indigenous perspective, the specific health concerns of Native Hawaiian and indigenous communities and how this is tied to natural environments. Students will also have an opportunity to participate in an internship and/or research giving them applied experience as they prepare to enter health fields. The new certificate is a unique contribution on campus because it will be the only public health offering and provides opportunities to a wide variety of majors who are seeking focused learning in public health. This certificate will complement a number of degree programs on campus including: KES, Sociology, pre-Pharmacy, Psychology, Anthropology, Exploratory Health Sciences and others.
