**SUBJECT: Proposed name change from Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE)
to Department of Civil, Environmental and Construction Engineering (CECE)**

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the President approve a name change of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering to the Department of Civil, Environmental and Construction Engineering within the College of Engineering, University of Hawaii at Manoa.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2023

ADDITIONAL COST:

There are minimal costs dealing with stationery and webpage changes.

PURPOSE:

The faculty of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering, College of Engineering, requests to change our name to the Department of Civil, Environmental and Construction Engineering. The name change more appropriately describes the degree programs of our students, which includes the Bachelor of Science, Master of Science, and Doctoral degrees in civil engineering (CE), and the Bachelor of Science degree in construction engineering (CNST). The name change does not involve any changes in the degree requirements for our undergraduate and graduate programs.

Pursuant to Board of Regents Policy, RP 5.201 Instructional Programs

G. Naming of Programs (Cross reference RP 11.204)

- 1. Programs are given a name at the time they are approved by the board. Thereafter, the president may approve changes in the functional names of academic programs and credentials as may become necessary to remain current with the terminology and focus of their fields and which involve no significant change in the program requirements.*
- 2. No program shall be given a name to honor a person without approval of the board.*

BACKGROUND:

Engineering classes began at the College of Hawai'i in 1908 with the first B.S. engineering graduate in 1912. The Department of Engineering was formed in 1920 and its Civil Engineering program was first accredited by ABET-EAC on October 19, 1951. The Department of Engineering was converted to the College of Engineering in 1958, and departments of electrical and mechanical engineering were added soon thereafter.

In 2001, the department of Civil Engineering faculty decided to change the department name to Civil and Environmental Engineering (CEE) because of the increased emphasis on environmental engineering, and the need to distinguish environmental engineering from environmental science and other programs at UH Manoa that dealt with environmental issues outside of engineering.

Development of a new Construction Engineering program (CNST) was initiated in 2017 because of the increasing need in the local construction industry for B.S. graduates with greater in-depth knowledge of construction practices. At a CEE department faculty meeting in May 2017 the faculty approved establishing a Construction Engineering degree program in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering. The University of Hawai'i Board of Regents approved the new B.S. program in Construction Engineering in March 2019. A dual BS degree program in civil (CE) and construction (CNST) engineering was approved by the Provost in October 2019. The first ABET-EAC evaluation of the B.S. in Construction Engineering was performed in November 2021 and accreditation is anticipated later this year.

With the addition of the CNST B.S. program, the department faculty discussed the possibility of adding "construction" to the department name. At a department meeting on February 11, 2022, the faculty voted to change the department name to the Department of Civil, Environmental and Construction Engineering. There are no conflicts with names and primary interests in other departments at UH Manoa.
