

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Chancellor approve a name change of the Department of Meteorology to the Department of Atmospheric Sciences within the School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2014

ADDITIONAL COST:

There are minimal costs dealing with stationery and web changes.

PURPOSE:

The faculty of the Department of Meteorology, School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology, wishes to change our name to the Department of Atmospheric Sciences. This name better describes our expanding interests in climate change, atmospheric chemistry, planetary scale processes and multi-disciplinary environmental research. Over the last few decades meteorology has been interpreted by many to mean a focus on hydrometeors (e.g., rain) or the forecasting of the weather which may have largely described the interests of the Department years ago but is inadequate now. The prospective name change also avoids the confusion often found in the general public who mistakenly think we are a branch of astronomy. My faculty, which conducted several discussions about the name change and subsequently voted to request the change, believes that our new name will enhance interest at the undergraduate and graduate

levels and be a step towards increasing enrollment in our program. The name change will not entail any changes in the degree requirements for our undergraduate and graduate programs.

I have not detected any conflicts in my preliminary examination of the names and primary interests in other departments at Mānoa. Please let me know if you have any issues with my Department's request and how I might help in its successful conclusion. Thank you for your consideration.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Pursuant to the Board of Regents Policy 5-1 (h.) "Naming of Programs."

(1) Programs are given a name at the time they are approved by the Board. Thereafter, the President may approve changes in the functional names of academic programs and credentials as may become necessary to remain current with terminology and focus of their fields and involve no significant changes in program requirements. Given that this is a department name change and not an academic program name change, the Chancellor has the authority to approve the action.

The Department of Meteorology currently offers a Bachelor of Science, a Master of Science and doctoral degrees. We are currently designing a Bachelor of Arts degree path to allow students wishing to have a stronger background for teaching the Atmospheric Sciences among other possible career paths.

The University has recently signed an agreement with the Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST) which has the largest Atmospheric Sciences program in the world. Future agreements between our two programs have the potential to substantially increase our enrollments at the graduate level.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the Chancellor approve the name change of the Department of Meteorology to the Department of Atmospheric Sciences, School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.
