

SUBJECT: Request to Amend the Degree Title of the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Theatre to the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that the President amend the degree title of the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Theatre to the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance, Department of Theatre and Dance, in College of Arts and Humanities at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. This program was approved by the Board of Regents in 1979. According to STAR, there have been 62 graduates. Per STAR data, there were eight students enrolled in the program in Fall 2013.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE

To be effective upon approval.

ADDITIONAL COST

None.

PURPOSE

The requested amendment will appropriately reflect the curriculum and intention of the degree. The change also aligns with standards of practice in the dance industry. Furthermore, having the degree properly titled will aid in recruiting incoming students and support graduating students when applying for jobs or further academic study.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to Board of Regents Policy 5-1. h(1), Instructional Programs, Naming of Programs, the President has the authority to approve changes in the functional names of academic programs and credentials that involve no significant change in program requirements.

Department of Theatre and Dance

The current BFA in Dance Theatre is designed for students who wish to pursue professional careers as dancers, teachers, and/or choreographers. The degree requires 60 credit hours in dance, including advanced-level dance technique courses. Theatre courses are not required for this degree other than two credits of lab (working with the costume department to facilitate other productions). This degree differs from the BA in Dance which is a generalist degree requiring only 32 credit hours in dance. We request that the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Theatre (BFA Dance Theatre) degree title be amended to Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance (BFA Dance) in order to accurately reflect the nature and intention of the BFA degree program.

ACTION RECOMMENDED

It is requested that the President amend the title of the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Theatre to the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance, effective upon approval.
