SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Chancellor approve the online delivery of the Bachelor of Arts in Economics (for degree completion) in the College of Social Sciences.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2018.

ADDITIONAL COST:

None.

PURPOSE:

The Senior Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) requires a substantive change review for programs whereby 50% or more of the major is available online. The BA in Economics was approved for hybrid delivery in Fall 2016. The College of Social Sciences is partnering with Hawai'i Community College and the UH Pālanuanui Campus to offer the BA in Economics for degree completion for students who complete the UH Associate of Arts degree. The attached proposal was completed to bring the program into compliance with WASC requirements, and to provide flexibility for students to complete their degrees across the state.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

UH Executive Policy E5.204 grants the Chancellor the authority to ensure accreditation standards are maintained for distance delivered programs.

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The BA in Economics provides students with an intensive knowledge of the theory and practice of economics, with an emphasis on the analysis of contemporary policy challenges of Hawai'i and the U.S. in the Asia-Pacific region. Majors study a wide range of current economic policy issues and learn theoretical and empirical methods for analyzing these issues. The BA in Economics has averaged 193 majors over the last 5-years (fall semester). The online availability of major requirements makes the BA in Economics ideal for degree completion, especially in partnership with the UH Community Colleges.

Dean Denise Konan, Dean William Chismar, my staff and I recommend your approval.

It is recommended that the Chancellor approve the Online BA in Economics for degree completion, to be effective Fall 2018.
