### SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that President approve the change in the name of the Doctor of Philosophy in International Management to the Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Fall 2015.

#### ADDITIONAL COST:

None.

### **PURPOSE:**

The requested name change will better reflect program content and will assist the program in recruiting more students. The proposed change aligns with standards in the field as determined by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business in that all graduate programs are expected to infuse international content throughout the curriculum. Given the expectation, "International" is not necessary in the degree title.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

According to the Board of Regents Policy 5-1.h (1) Instructional Programs, Naming of Programs, the President may approve changes in the operative and functional names of academic programs and credentials as may become necessary to remain current with

the terminology and focus of their fields and involve no significant change in program requirements.

The PhD in International Management, approved by the Board of Regents in 1998, is the only doctoral program in business in the state that is accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB). As of Fall 2014, there were 24 students enrolled in the program. The program has graduated 55 students who are generally placed in academic positions at research institutions nationally and internationally. The few exceptions over the last seven years include 3 in industry (law firm, financial institution, think tank) and one with a government agency. Geographically, program graduates place in the Asia and Pacific region, continental United States, and Hawai'i.

The proposed name change will better reflect the overall content of the degree, and will attract more students with broad interests in business. Per AACSB standards, all graduate programs in business should contain significant international content, therefore the use of the word "International" in the degree title is not needed. Further, we have found that International Management as a degree title is a deterrent for students interested in Business Administration, which is covered extensively in the curriculum. We anticipate that the PhD in Business Administration will attract more students in the future. AACSB has been informed of our intention to change the name of the degree to Business Administration.

#### ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that President approve the change in the name of the Doctor of Philosophy in International Management to the Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration, effective Fall 2015, in the Shidler College of Business.
