SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is respectfully requested that the Chancellor approve a stop-out of admissions to the MASTERS OF GEOSCIENCE (MGeo) in preparation for program termination.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Effective Fall 2018 through Spring 2020 (semester final student expected to graduate).

ADDITIONAL COST:

No additional cost.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this action is to prepare for the termination of the MASTERS OF GEOSCIENCE by stopping the admission of new students and allowing existing students to complete the program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Pursuant to Executive Policy E5.202, the chancellors may approve a stop-out of admission to a program.

MASTERS OF GEOSCIENCE program enrollment has continued to be low (1-3) new students per year) since inception. The program, which is a Plan B, has apparently insurmountable issues with recruitment, course scheduling, and the internship. Although conceptually this program still has potential, GG department faculty have not been able to make the necessary modifications to grow enrollment. They propose to roll the program into their regular MS Plan B program in Geology and Geophysics as a track and continue to refine.
