


SUBJECT: Request for Approval of Stop-Out of Admission to the Doctor of Public Health Program

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED

It is respectfully requested that the Chancellor approve a stop-out of admissions to the Doctor of Public Health (DrPH) program.

Due to recent changes in accreditation standards by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH), the accrediting body for our degree-granting programs, we are requesting a stop-out of new admission to our DrPH program. We are in the process of obtaining approval to change our degree from the DrPH to a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Public Health. The request is for a change in name only, not for a change in program content.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective from the Fall 2018 semester through Fall 2023.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

There will be no additional costs associated with this request.

PURPOSE

To suspend and stop-out the admission of any new students into the DrPH program as we pursue a degree name change to a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Public Health.

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BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Executive Policy E5.202, Chancellors may approve a "stop-out" of admission to a program.


The most recent curriculum change for the DrPH program was a change in required hours which was approved in May 2014.

There is a need to stop-out admission to the DrPH program as we pursue a change in degree name to avoid confusing future applicants and misrepresenting our doctoral program, which now better aligns with our accrediting body's definition of a PhD in Public Health.

ACTION RECOMMENDED

It is respectfully requested that the Chancellor approve a stop-out of admissions to the Doctor of Public Health program effective Fall 2018 through Fall 2023.
