

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

We are requesting continuance of the stop-out of new admissions to the PK-3 Graduate Certificate in the Department of Curriculum Studies in the College of Education for a period of two (2) years, from ~~the beginning of the Spring 2021 semester through the beginning of the Fall 2023~~ semester, to be reevaluated after two (2) years.

ADDITIONAL COST:

There are no additional costs associated with this request.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the request is to continue the stop-out of admission of students into the PK-3 Graduate Certificate for up to two (2) years. The Department of Curriculum Studies faculty are currently re-organizing early childhood education pathways in light of Provost Bruno's COVID-19 directive, starting with consolidating and streamlining programs and providing opportunities leading to teacher licensure in early childhood. The faculty are reviewing our existing Master's level options to merge coursework into one program so that the College is better positioned to sustain an early childhood education offering at the graduate level in the fiscally challenging years ahead.

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We foresee a need to keep open the possibility to revise and offer enrollment in the PK-3 Certificate in the future. A PK-3 Certificate would enable the College of Education to create an educational pathway for students seeking a license in the field who may not want a master's degree. Reworked, a PK-3 Certificate could provide another avenue to address a statewide need for teachers with an early childhood license in Hawai'i.

BACKGROUND:

Initially, students in the PK-3 Certificate program were fully funded with scholarships from the Kellogg Foundation. Enrollment was moderate to high at the time. When funding ended, enrollment dropped to an unsustainable level. Curriculum Studies offers one master's degree in early childhood education as well as the PK-3 Graduate Certificate. The Department is currently reviewing the early childhood education program options and collaborating with the Institute for Teacher Education for possible re-organization of some program offerings. All programs will continue to address the new Professional Standards and Competencies in Early Childhood Education (2020).

There is a trend towards the long term need for a graduate level certificate that can address the need for teacher licensing in early childhood education, separate from a master's degree, as a result of increases in public school PreK classrooms. ACT 46, passed in the 2020 legislative session, calls for 50% of all underserved three- and four-year-old children in Hawai'i to have access to a preschool program by December 31, 2027 and 100% of preschool aged children to have access by December 31, 2032. However, there is a pause on public PreK expansion as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our current early childhood education license programs at the bachelor's and graduate levels can accommodate the existing need. However, it may be necessary to revisit the PK-3 Certificate when it is possible to increase faculty resources and after the economy recovers. When the state renews interest in rapid PreK expansion, a PK-3 certificate will help address the need to expand the workforce.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

We are requesting continuance of the stop-out of new admissions to the PK-3 Graduate Certificate in the Department of Curriculum Studies in the College of Education for a period of two (2) years, from ~~the beginning of the Spring 2021 semester through the beginning of the Fall 2023 semester~~, to be reevaluated after two (2) years.
