After a discussion with Ryan Yamaguchi, Assistant Director of Admissions and Megumi Makino-Kanehiro, Director of the Manoa Advising Center (MAC), it was proposed that Pre-Medical Technology (Pre-MEDT) students, who are now officially housed under MAC, be moved under the Medical Technology program.

Since the Medical Technology program was changed so that students are required to complete their MLT certification at Kapiolani Community College or other accredited programs it is crucial that students are provided with the information necessary to fulfill this requirement. While it may be possible for a student to complete one semester at UHM, the way that the program is structured requires that the student transfer to KCC at some point in order to complete their MLT.

There was discussion that perhaps the Pre-MEDT category should be eliminated entirely, but it was agreed that every effort should be made to retain students who are interested in attending the University, especially since a number of these students do not ultimately end up choosing Medical Technology as their major.

This change is being proposed in order to promote early contact of Pre-MEDT students so that they can be appropriately referred to the Medical Technology program for further consultation and planning assistance or referred out to MAC for discussion of major selection.

We request that all oversight of the Pre-Medical Technology students, including forms, academic action be given to Medical Technology, to be effective once this memo is approved.
