It is requested that the President approve removal of the Neurosciences Specialization from the Psychology Graduate Program.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this request is to formalize current practice in the Psychology Graduate Program. Although approved by President Simone in 1989, the Psychology Graduate Program has never admitted students into the Neurosciences Specialization, nor does it have any intention of doing so in the future.


BACKGROUND:

The Psychology Department has three program areas: (1) Clinical Psychology, (2) Community, Culture, and Developmental, and (3) Cognition, Neuroscience, and Social); and one specialization: Clinical Respecialization. Many years ago, multiple colleges (including the College of Social Sciences) signed an agreement to develop an interdisciplinary Neuroscience Specialization program. However, due to various factors, the Neurosciences Specialization program was never established in our department and we have never admitted students into it. The current listing of this non-established program as a choice for applicants to the Psychology Graduate Program has resulted in considerable confusion for many applicants. Therefore, we kindly request that the Neurosciences Specialization be removed from the Psychology Graduate Program.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the President approve removal of the Neurosciences Specialization from the Psychology Graduate Program.
