The purpose of this change in degree name is to accurately reflect the curricular focus of the degree program to current and prospective students and colleagues and keep pace with the evolution of the discipline.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to EP 5.201, Approval of New Academic Programs and Review of Provisional Programs, degree program name changes are delegated by the Board of Regents to the President.

The MS graduate program in Clinical and Translational Research has two tracks, Clinical Research and Quantitative Health Sciences. The program is housed within the Department of Quantitative Health Sciences, where the majority of its faculty members have expertise in various aspects of quantitative health research, such as biostatistics and bioinformatics.

In both course curricula and research experiences, the graduate program not only includes clinical research, but also in-depth learning of many aspects of quantitative health sciences. To increase the effectiveness of recruitment and more accurately represent the specialties of the faculty members in the department and the program, we propose a name change from "Clinical and Translational Research" to "Quantitative Health and Clinical Research".

Given the significant shortage in the quantitative health sciences workforce currently and projected for the future, the proposed program name change will better attract promising students who are interested in various quantitative research career paths, and be more relevant as they embark on their careers to help meet the critical need of quantitative health scientists in the healthcare workforce of Hawai'i and the Pacific region.

As a change in the degree name has no budget or other broader impacts, this proposal has been reviewed and approved by the department and graduate program faculty and staff. No comment or concerns were made.
