PURPOSE:

To conduct a review and redesign of Master of Arts degree curriculum and program.

BACKGROUND:

EP 5.202 describing the review of established programs allows for a program to request a stop-out of admissions for a set period while the program undergoes a redesign to, among other things, attract greater


enrollments and improve time to degree. Chancellors are given the authorization to approve admission stop-outs.

As part of the UH Mānoa Planning for Post-Pandemic Hawai'i, the Provost and his Budget Team addressed issues of concern with the Department of Religion, including its enrollments and its attractiveness for recruitment as a graduate degree. The several proposals discussed that might improve the program would be best initiated under a stop-out of admissions during the current and subsequent academic year. With new curriculum and program initiatives in place, admissions would resume for AY 2022-23.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

We would like to recommend a stop-out of admissions into the Master of Arts degree in Religion for Fall 2021 through Spring 2022.
