COURSE SUBJECT CODE FROM WS TO WGSS

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the change in title of the undergraduate certificate, advanced graduate certificate, BA Honors Track, and course subject from Women's Studies to Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies, and the course subject code from WS to WGSS be approved.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2021.

ADDITIONAL COST:

There is no additional cost associated with this request.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this change in title of certificate programs, honors track, course subject and course subject code, is to be consistent with the recent change of department's name and degree to Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies, and to accurately reflect the curricular focus of the department to our current and prospective students and colleagues and keep pace with the evolution of the discipline.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to EP 5.201, Approval of New Academic Programs and Review of Provisional Programs, program name changes are delegated by the Board of Regents to the President.

The Department of Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies at the University of Hawaii at Manoa has just celebrated its 40th anniversary. Situated within a rich net of resources for the study of women and gender in the Asia Pacific region, external reviews have noted that our programs are among the top 30 such departments in the U.S. with exceptionally strong faculty and a robust curriculum. Since receiving department status, 2007 enrollments have steadily increased as course offerings have

expanded and evolved. The department attracts a mix of students and courses specifically addressing gender and sexuality often attract equal proportions of female and male students.

At the same time, we periodically contend with what we have come to refer to as the 'truth in advertising problem' wherein many students find our courses relatively late in their academic careers and express frustration that they did not know our department had such a strong focus on gender and sexuality studies. While this has long been a specialty focus within our department, our department title and degree names had failed to communicate this fact widely. Moreover, across the U.S. women's studies programs and departments have been updating their titles for the past 10-15 years to reflect trends in the field and most departments have added gender and/or sexuality to their titles. For instance, our peer and benchmark institutions have indeed renamed their departments and degrees: Oregon State University (BA and BS in and Department of Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies); University of Colorado, Boulder (BA in and Department of Women and Gender Studies); and University of California, Davis (BA in and Department of Gender, Sexuality and Women's Studies).

This proposal has been reviewed by Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies faculty and staff and the College of Social Sciences. Bryan Kim (on behalf of Social Sciences Division at UH-Hilo, where Gender and Women's Studies program is a part of) provided support on January 29th, Celia Bardwell-Jones (on behalf of Gender and Women's Studies at UH-Hilo) provided support on January 25th, and Monique Mironesco (on behalf of Gender Studies at UH-West Oahu) provided support on January 19th. This proposal was shared with the Council of Chief Academic Officers on February 3rd, and no concerns were raised regarding the changes.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the change in title of the undergraduate certificate, advanced graduate certificate, BA Honors Track, and course subject from Women's Studies to Women, Gender, and Sexuality Studies, and the course subject code from WS to WGSS be approved.

Hi Max:

Just to clarify: Is what you meant: students who have been admitted to our program can still choose to be granted either a WS or WGSS degree by Fall 2025, and that we will stop admitting students for WS right away (meaning in the Fall, all students will be admitted as WGSS students)? If so, yes, I confirm. Thank you!

My suggestion would be to implement the new major descriptions as soon as possible so we can dissolve the College of A&S completely by the start of the Spring 2021 semester. Since the curriculum is not changing in the existing BA program (just the title), I agree that the new description should take effect Fall 2021.

Regarding the old degree name (Women's Studies BA), since there are 8 students that have admit terms of Fall 2021 or Spring 2021, I think stopping out the old program name effective Fall 2025 makes sense. This would at least give students a choice to be coded as WMST(16) or WGSS. The latest data pull shows that there are 33 students in the major, so either way, updating the students to the new program name should not be a problem. Ayu, Denise - if you can confirm this will work for you (stopping out admission for the old program name of WMST effective Fall 2025), I will submit the PCR request to Grant.

Ryan can you confirm if it's too late to make a change of title for Fall 2021 in EAB? It would need to wait for Spring 2022 or Fall 2022, correct? If this is the case, we will need to manually move admitted students out of the old program code to the new program code in Banner.

- 3) Fall 2025 termination of WS degree WITH the OPTION to manually change to a new degree, if the student requests a new name. OR, ANOTHER POSSIBILITY is to change the degree with WGSS starting Fall 2021, and to manually change to an old degree (until Fall 2025), since less students want the old degree. Either way is fine with us.
