PURPOSE:

The purpose of this change in title and degree name is to accurately reflect the curricular focus of the department to our current and prospective students and colleagues and keep pace with the evolution of the discipline and to respond to the recommendation of such a name change made by UH-President and Manoa Budget Team.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to APM A3.101, University of Hawaii Organizational and Functional Changes and EP 5.201, Approval of New Academic Programs and Review of Provisional Programs, unit name changes and program name changes are delegated by the Board of Regents to the President.
