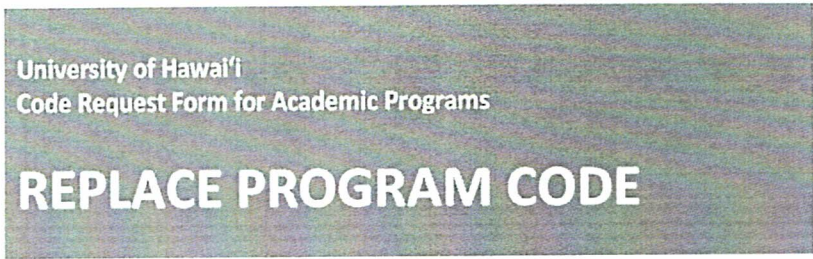






Description: The Associate in Sciences in Digital Media Production provides creative individuals with the art and design training needed to explore and express ideas using leading-edge technology and skill-sets. Students receive integrated digital media training in one of six specializations: Animation and Motion Graphics, Creative Media, Digital Photography, Digital Video for the Web, Internet Publishing and Video Games. Students become life-long learners, developing the skills required for a vast array of digital media communications, two-dimensional and three-dimensional animation, video games and interactive media.

The changes are necessary to align with current digital media practices in industry. There is one substantive change, the reinstatement of the Digital Media Specialization in Digital Photography. There is no other Digital Photography Specialization degree in the entire UH system, and this specialization meets the College's mission noted in the 2008-2015 Strategic Plan:

1. Work Force Development: To provide the trained workforce needed in the State, the Asia-Pacific region, and internationally by offering occupational, technical, and professional courses and programs which prepare students for immediate and future employment and career advancement.
2. Personal Development: To provide opportunities for personal enrichment, occupational upgrading, and career mobility through credit and non-credit courses and activities.

There was previous concern about adequate facilities primarily for ART 277, Studio Photography. After discussion with the affected photography instructors, it was found that a section of BS-109 (a DMED lab) could be utilized as a functional studio space. This current version of the Specialization in Digital Photography was carefully crafted in collaboration with the aforementioned instructors to ensure a series of courses that could lead to potential employment and working independently with commercial clients.
