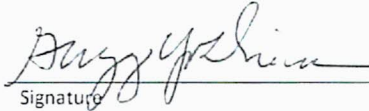

Title: Digital Media Production

Description: The Associate in Sciences in Digital Media Production provides creative individuals with the art and design training needed to explore and express ideas using leading-edge technology and skill-sets. Students receive integrated digital media training in one of six specializations: Animation and Motion Graphics, Creative Media, Digital Photography, Digital Video for the Web, and Internet Publishing. Students become life-long learners, developing the skills required for a vast array of digital media communications, two-dimensional and three-dimensional animation.

Deleted Specialization in Video Games.

The deletion of the Specialization in Video Games was done since it was found that the coursework in this specialization was not substantive enough to develop the comprehensive skills necessary to compete in this field.

The need to replace ART 115, Introduction to Design to ART 115D, Digital Design is because it was discovered that ART 115 has not been offered by the Art Department for several years. Additionally, the content in the digital design course is more current and appropriate for the Specialization in Digital Photography.
