As you can see from the attached VCAA memo dated April 6, 2022, we previously had approved the CO-CHW Community Health Worker Certificate, but UHCC did not approve Hawai'i CC to offer the program, so the campus retired the certificate. We have recently received approval from UHCC and would like your support in reactivating this certificate in our systems.

The certificate is in Kuali, but I would like CRC to review and make a notation in the system if they approve. Once CRC has updated Kuali, I would ask that the certificate be added back to the catalog, STAR, and the admissions application. My preference is for this to be effective Spring 2024, if possible, but I understand that some systems may lag according to the process for each system.

I look forward to the Curriculum Review Committee's decision.
