SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that admissions to the Sustainability Science Certificate of Achievement (CA), the Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture Associate of Science (AS) and Certificate of Achievement (CA), and the the Business Technology Associate in Applied Science (AAS), Certificate of Achievement (CA), and Certificate of Competence (CO) programs be stopped out for the period beginning with the approval of this request and continuing until July 1, 2020.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

It is requested that the stop-out be effective upon approval of this request and continue until July 1, 2020.

ADDITIONAL COST:

No anticipated additional costs.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this action is to temporarily stop-out admissions to the Sustainability Science, Certificate of Achievement (CA); the Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture, Associate of Science (AS) and Certificate of Achievement (CA); Business Technology, Associate in Applied Science (AAS), Certificate of Achievement (CA), and Certificate of Competence (CO).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

As per the Board of Regents policy Chapter 5, RP 5.201, "reviews of particular programs may be undertaken at any time as deemed necessary", and "a program with a low number of degree/certificates of achievement conferred will undergo a campus level review."

These programs have low enrollment and few certificates awarded.

Sustainability Science CA

Though students express an interest in, and recognize the importance of sustainability science, few are enrolling for and completing the CA. This is an opportune time to stop-out the low-enrolled Sustainability Science CA while the institution evaluates the program for improvements that might make it more marketable.

Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture

The institution's Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture instructor has recently relocated to UII Hilo, making this an appropriate time to stop-out the low enrolled AS and CA pathways, however the Academic Subject Certificate (ASC) will continue to be offered.

Business Technology

Enrollment in the Business Technology program has been low and has continued to decline. And, though the program has undergone some revisions to make it more industry relevant, the one instructor to the program has recently resigned. With continued low enrollment and the resignation of the program coordinator/instructor this is also an opportune time to stop-out this program while a longer-term decision for its future is explored.

Additionally, in accordance with the expectations of ACCIC Accreditation Standards and as per RP 5.201, "Commitments to students already officially enrolled in such programs shall be met and limited for up to two years for associate degrees at community college programs...".

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

Approval to temporarily stop-out admission of new students to the following programs from the date of approval until July 1, 2020:

- Sustainability Science, Certificate of Achievement (CA);
- Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture, Associate of Science (AS);
- Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture, Certificate of Achievement (CA);
- Business Technology, Associate in Applied Science (AAS);
- Business Technology, Certificate of Achievement (CA); and the
- Business Technology, Certificate of Competence (CO)
