#### SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Sustainability Science Certificate of Achievement (CA) and Tropical Agriculture Certificate of Achievement (CA) be terminated

#### **RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Spring 2021

#### **ADDITIONAL COST:**

None.

#### **PURPOSE:**

The requested terminations are the result of consistently low enrollments across these certificates and is an effort to minimize campus costs during a time of necessary budgetary austerity.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Board of Regents Policy, <u>RP 5.201 states:</u> "reviews of particular programs may be undertaken at any time as deemed necessary", and "a program with a low number of degree/certificates of achievement conferred will undergo a campus level review." These certificate programs have had low enrollment and few certificates and degrees awarded. As a result, they were stopped out through July 1, 2020, and have not accepted new students. Moreover, the PBTA program was granted Provisional status on May 15, 2014, and was never awarded Established status. From 2014-2020, there have only been:

- 7 graduates earning the Sustainability Science Management (CA) and
- 7 graduates earning the Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture (CA).

The Program Coordinator and primary faculty for the Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture (PBTA) program moved to a position at UH Hilo in August 2018. Budgetary limitations have kept the campus from immediately replacing the faculty member and the current hiring freeze required the campus to cancel the search begun to fill this position for August 2020. Without a full-time faculty member to revise and revitalize the PBTA program, the program's immediate success is improbable. Approval from the president will also be sought to terminate the PBTA (AS) in a separate memo. The college intends to keep PBTA/agriculture COs and to place them under a CTE pathway. For those students seeking a research-based agriculture career, the college intends to create an Associate of Science Natural Science agriculture pathway.

For Sustainability Science, the campus has instead made a commitment to embed Sustainability Science across the curriculum to benefit students on all majors rather than to retain the low enrolled CA.

<u>UHCCP 5.203</u> Program Credentials: Degree and Certificates III.B.2.f. provides the Chancellor with authority to approve CAs that consist of courses within an existing Board approved associate degree. Thus, the Chancellor has the authority to take action on these CAs directly.

Additionally, Kaua'i CC has complied with the expectations of ACCJC Accreditation Standards and as per RP 5.201, "Commitments to students already officially enrolled in such programs shall be met and limited for up to two years for associate degrees at community college programs..." All students on this currently stopped-out program (stopped out August 31, 2018 thru July, 2020) have been provided a pathway to completion. By default these programs have remained stopped out thru this date.

It is requested that the Sustainability Science Certificate of Achievement (CA) and Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture Certificate of Achievement (CA) be terminated.
