ETRO 18 is being removed from the program due to lack of qualified lecturers and the moratorium for hiring tenure track faculty.

Skilled carpenters are required in areas of new building construction, repair, and alteration of buildings. This program also enhances the graduates entry into the carpenters apprenticeship program.
