SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Geographic Information Systems Certificate of Competence (CO and Advanced Geographic Information Systems Certificate of Competence (CO) be stopped out fall 2021 and terminated fall 2022.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Stop out fall 2021 and termination fall 2022

ADDITIONAL COST:

None.

PURPOSE:

These certificates have been largely inactive due to challenges in building a qualified lecturer pool for three consecutive years and subsequently low enrollments due to limited course offerings during this time frame. These certificates are not part of an existing full-time faculty member's teaching workload and consequently requires paying overload or hiring of lecturers.

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Elimination of these certificates is an effort to minimize campus costs, by necessarily reducing lecturer costs during a time of essential budgetary austerity and towards the president's goal of right-sizing our institutions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Board of Regents Policy, <u>RP 5.201 states:</u> "reviews of particular programs may be undertaken at any time as deemed necessary", and "a program with a low number of degree/certificates of achievement conferred will undergo a campus level review." To that end, these two certificates have had low enrollments and with minimal student interest, coupled with budgetary constraints, these certificates should be stopped out and terminated so that campus resources can be allocated to more viable programs. There was merely one CO awarded from this program each of the following semesters: spring 2017, fall 2017, and fall 2018.

Additionally, this Geographic Information Systems program might be more suitable to our Office of Continuing Education and Training (OCET) where revenue can be generated through enrollments and is possibly more appealing to our working and industry community members in a format other than 16 weeks of classes and during which one might build upon their workforce skill set.

<u>UHCCP 5.203</u> Program Credentials: Degree and Certificates III.B.2.j. provides the Chancellor with the authority to approve a CO as a, "stand-alone college credential for students who have successfully completed a sequence of career and technical education courses not within a BOR-approved CTE program that has been identified as fulfilling an employable set of skills recognized by Business and Industry". Thus, the Chancellor has the authority to take action on these COs directly.

Finally, Kaua'i CC has complied with the expectations of ACCJC Accreditation Standards and as per RP 5.201, "Commitments to students already officially enrolled in such programs shall be met...". The college is first stopping-out and will subsequently terminate these certificate programs in compliance with standard expectations.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is requested that the Geographic Information Systems Certificate of Competence (CO and Advanced Geographic Information Systems Certificate of Competence (CO) be stopped out fall 2021 and terminated spring 2022.
