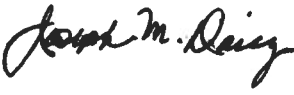

SUBJECT: REQUEST TO STOP-OUT AND THEN TERMINATE
SUSTAINABILITY SCIENCE CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE
(CO)

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Sustainability Science Certificate of Competence (CO) be stopped-out for spring 2021 and terminated fall 2021.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Spring 2021

ADDITIONAL COST:

None.

PURPOSE:

The requested stop-out and termination is the result of consistently low enrollments for this certificate and is an effort to minimize campus lecturer costs during a time of necessary budgetary austerity and in accordance with the right-sizing initiative.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Board of Regents Policy, RP 5.201 states: “reviews of particular programs may be undertaken at any time as deemed necessary”, and “a program with a low number of degree/certificates of achievement conferred will undergo a campus level review.” This certificate program has had low enrollment and few certificates and degrees awarded. The related SSM CA was stopped out through July 1, 2020 and was recently terminated on January 13, 2021. From 2016-2018 there were only 13 total students having earned this Sustainability Science CO (2016, one graduate; 2017, two graduates; 2018, ten graduates; and 2019, zero graduates). One graduate was a member of the faculty (non-revenue generating). One remaining student has declared this CO and in collaboration with counseling the college will ensure that students earns the CO this semester via a course substitution.

For Sustainability Science, the campus has instead made a commitment to embed Sustainability Science across the curriculum to benefit students on all majors rather than to retain this low enrolled CO.

UHCCP 5.203 Program Credentials: Degree and Certificates III.B.2.i. provides the Chancellor with authority to approve COs that are, “a stand-alone college credential for students who have successfully completed a sequence of career and technical education courses not within a BOR-approved CTE program that has been identified as fulfilling an employable set of skills recognized by Business and Industry”. Thus, the Chancellor has the authority to stop-out and terminate this CO. Additionally, this CO does not explicitly meet an industry or business credential/standard.

Kaua'i CC has complied with the expectations of ACCJC Accreditation Standards and as per RP 5.201, “Commitments to students already officially enrolled in such programs shall be met...No new program admissions shall take place”. The remaining student on this CO will earn the CO this spring and by stopping-out the program no further students will be added so that the CO can be officially terminated fall 2021.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is requested that the Sustainability Science Certificate of Competence (CO) be stopped out spring 2021 and terminated fall 2021.
