SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to terminate the provisional Associate in Science (AS) degree and Certificate of Achievement (CA) in Construction Management (CMGT) at Honolulu Community College.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Admissions stop-out in effect for Fall 2015. Degree termination to take place Spring 2017, with last graduating class in Spring 2017.

ADDITIONAL COST:

There are no additional costs to this request.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this request is to terminate the provisional Associate of Science degree in Construction Management. This will include the removal of the Academic Program Code in Banner.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In accordance with BOR Policy E5.202 Review of Established Programs, Honolulu Community College is requesting approval from the UH President to terminate the provisional Associate in Science (AS) degree in Construction Management.

This degree was originally created and provisionally approved in 2012 to provide a coordinated undergraduate program of preparation for middle level management needs of the construction industry. Recruitment strategies to identify early program participants targeted students from the Honolulu Community College's Construction Academy as well as individuals from the current construction industry workforce. Plans also included the development of a partnership with the UHM College of Engineering.

Projected student enrollment and completion goals placed approximately 40 students entering per year, totaling enrollment over the next three years at 80 majors. Actual student enrollment and student completions have been significantly lower with an average of 20 students entering each year with the first graduating class of three students. Further program and curricular modifications will not prepare students to transition to UH Mānoa because the lack of appropriate science and math requirements.

The College has determined the provisional program does not appropriately meet and address current and projected workforce demands. During the 2015-2016 academic year, the College has identified other opportunities to continue offering construction management related courses in other established construction related degrees and continuing education programs.

Honolulu Community College will continue to work directly with all CMGT program majors who have signed and returned a statement of intention declaring their future academic goals. Coordinated efforts throughout the College have been implemented to maintain consistent communication with students regarding changes to the program, and information to access various academic support services. The Spring 2017 semester will serve as the terminal semester for final degree confirmation.

Approval to terminate the provisional Associate in Science (AS) degree and Certificate of Achievement in Construction Management (CMGT) at Honolulu Community College.
