PROPOSAL SUMMARY (Include reasons for modifying program.):

Creation of a Certificate of Achievement.

Adding a Certificate of Achievement to the CMGT program will allow us to serve the incumbent work force demographic who wish to enhance their skills with a broad offering of our core program courses. This pathway will also provide UHM School of Engineering graduates an opportunity to further their education towards a possible career in construction management with courses not currently offered at UHM SOE. Ultimately, this additional track will provide another option to individuals who are seeking the opportunity to achieve a skillset that will make them more employable.

Modification of Program Prerequisites.

After reviewing assessment results, having certain existing prerequisite requirements did not show any significant advantage towards a students success following the completion of their first semester program courses.

New CMGT 114 Course

Will replace current AEC 118 as a required course. The basis of this modification is due to assessment results concluding that the course content needs to have a higher concentration on construction methods rather than material types. (Also for A.S. degree)

New CMGT 211 Course

Will replace current CE 211 as a required course. CE 211 has not been offered at HonCC or UHM for many years and is no longer listed as an active course at UHM College of Engineering so articulation with COE is no longer valid. Because the course has not been utilized or offered recently by any program other than CMGT, the existing course content does not reflect the changes in technology and current best practices. The newly created course will realize these updates and also structure content toward students in our program. (Also Car A. S. degree)
