#### PROPOSAL SUMMARY (Include reasons for modifying program.):

Currently the Fire and Emergency Response Program (Fire Program) at Honolulu Community College has become outdated and needs to make a few course changes that will also impact the program. After significant research and outreach to our communities and constituents including our Medical Control Physician, Dr. James Ireland and in consultation with the Fire Program Advisory Board (comprised of all fire chiefs across the State of Hawaii). It is in the best interest of our future graduates as we prepare them for the job market by increasing the amount and quality of Emergency Medical Technician skills they graduate with.

The most recent data of our fire serives nationwide demonstrates a large increase in the number of medically oriented calls our graudates will respond to as entry level fire personnel. In order to prepare them for this competitive job market our program must be dynamic and robust which requires constant curricula and program reorientation. For example, Honolulu Fire Department was included in the 218 fire department 33 year study conducted by "Fire House Magazine", a leading reliable publication related to firefighting. This comprehensive study covered 44 States and represented 84,581,118 people with combined budgets totaling \$16 billion, 3,916 engine companies, 1,413 ladder companies, 2,109 ambulances and numerous specialized units. They reponded to 1,813,046 fire calls, 8,6631,179 EMS calls and 12,151,442 total calls in 2013. Honolulu Fire Departments busiest fire engine, Engine-1 was the 149th busiest Engine in the United States with 2,001 total calls in 2013. HFD's Station 2 was the 161st busiest station in the study with 3,428 runs with 3 units.

HFD reponded to a total of 48,963 calls. 1,742 of those calls were fire calls, 28,399 were EMS calls, 3,438 flase alarms. The current trend is obvious, (26,657 more medical calls than fire calls responded to by HFD in Honolulu in 2013) and the pressure turns to those provding the training and education to prepare our fire personnel to have the skills required. There is a significant need to update the Fire Program at HCC increasing our graduates ability to have the desired certifications upon graduation that will allow them to save lives when they arrive on scene. Our current Emergency Medical Technician Basic is outdated and does not meet the current standards in the State of Hawaii to provide the level of care required. It has served us well up to this point but needs important and critical updating, retooling, cognitive and psyhomotor skills upgrades, more staff, and more dedicated classroom time.

We will be increasing the Fire Program EMT requirement to meet current State of Hawaii standards which will require one intensive dedicated semester in achieving the certification. A new full time faculty as well as skills testing certified paramedics will be required to implement this third semester program. New equipment and supplies will also be needed to meet this standard as well. The fire Program and HCC can not afford to not udate our program, staff and equipment (See Page 3 additional Information)...
