SUBJECT: REQUEST TO STOP-OUT THE APC IN CULINARY MANAGEMENT

**PROGRAM** 

This is a request to stop out the admission of new students to the Advanced Professional Certificate in Culinary Management (APC-CULN-CLM) program effective Summer 2023.

The APC in Culinary Management program is designed for students who have obtained their AS degree in Culinary Arts and are interested in becoming chefs and/or those who intend to continue into the BAS in Culinary Management program offered at the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu. The program started in Fall 2011 and has been on provisional status with an approved extension to June 2023.

The impact of the COVID pandemic has affected the APC program enrollment significantly. The Culinary Arts Department will be revising the APC curriculum to attract an untapped market of students including industry professionals and culinary enthusiasts. The focus will be on the development of specialized courses that are not part of the traditional culinary curriculum but are part of the nouveau culinary industry/culture in which additional training/education is necessary.

New culinary experimental courses are currently being proposed and will be offered in Summer 2023. These experimental courses will be officially submitted to be part of the revised APC in Fall 2024. The revised APC in Culinary Management program will be implemented in Fall 2025 with the reactivation of the APC-CULN-CLM banner code.
