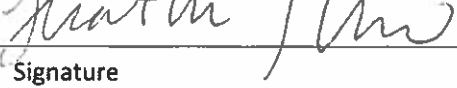

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that Honolulu Community College change the program name from the Computing, Electronics, and Networking Technology (CENT) to the Computing, Security, and Networking Technology (CSNT) program. The action requested will replace the program name change memo approved by President Lassner on July 16, 2018 to correctly reflect the program's name.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2019

ADDITIONAL COST:

None

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this program name modification is to better reflect the core focus areas of the current program and does not include significant changes to any program requirements. Security is a major focus for the College's current program, and Electronics is outdated and no longer taught. With the current national focus on cyber security, changing the program name will

better reflect the focus of our program, attract more interest from prospective students and strategically position graduates to reflect Computing, Security and Networking Technology on the student's academic credentials.

BACKGROUND:

Executive Policy EP5.201.IIIB Approval of New Academic Programs and Review of Provisional Academic Programs, "Requests to change academic program titles in order to maintain currency in terminology and involving no substantive change in the program or service group are made to the Vice President for Academic Affairs at Mānoa or to Chancellors, utilizing the E5.201 action memo format."

The CENT program is the former Electronics Technology (ETRON) program at HonCC. Effective Spring 1997, in response to changes in technology and the evolution of the program, the name of the ETRON program was changed to CENT.

The program has been nationally and locally recognized as a program of excellence. The Department of Homeland Security and the National Security Agency reviewed Honolulu Community College's program in the field of Cyber Defense Education and determined that the program met the nationally established criteria for the depth and maturity of an established program. In 2015, Honolulu Community College was designated as a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense Two-Year Education (CAE2Y/CD) through academic year 2021. Prior to that, HCC was designated as a National Center of Academic Excellence for Information Assurance Two-Year Education (CAE2Y/IA) in 2013.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the President approve HonCC's request to change the program name from the Computing, Electronics, and Networking Technology (CENT) to the Computing, Security, and Networking Technology (CSNT) program. The action requested will replace the program name change memo approved by President Lassner on July 16, 2018 to correctly reflect the program's name.
