Subject: Change in Alpha: GEOG to GEO

It has come to my attention that the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa has changed its GEOG alpha to GEO. To align with this change, promote consistency in course alphas, and best serve our transfer pathways, by way of this memo, I am asking that Kapi'olani Community College join the other community colleges in making this same change, to be effective Fall 2021. Given the timeline of schedule building for the Fall 2021 semester, the change in alpha will need to be completed by early January 2021.

While changes in curriculum usually need to follow the established process, I will be asking that this change be made administratively since the change does not involve content, credits, assessment methodology, or teaching equivalencies. This change, however, will need to be made across multiple platforms: the published catalog, the Banner catalog, STAR rules, and eventually course and program proposals in KSCM.
