PURPOSE: Facilitate the visibility of environmental science-related coursework and the Global Environmental Science major to both prospective and current undergraduate students in the

At this time, neither one of these locations explicitly lists GES-related courses. One would have to know to look under "OCN" in both these locations to find the GES/environmental science courses.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Much of the core GES curriculum falls under the "OCN" subject code as the program and courses were created through the Oceanography faculty and department. Many of these courses are not oceanography-subject specific though and this situation can result in prospective students or current undergraduates being confused or unaware as to where environmental science-related courses (and the major) can be found.

With the creation of the GES subject code, GES-related courses would be explicitly listed in the aforementioned prime locations (i.e., the UHM course catalog and semesterly subject code course listings) where current and prospective students browse for possible courses and ideas for a major to pursue.

The GES subject code would also allow for GES courses to be cross-listed with other subject codes.

In summary, the GES subject code would provide greater visibility for environmental science courses and the GES major.

<u>ACTION RECOMMENDED:</u> It is recommended that the interim Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs approve the creation of "GES" as a new Banner subject code associated the GES Program.
