It is requested that Interim Associate Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs approve the creation of a new Banner Subject Code (BSC), "NAVL" for the Naval Science and Leadership program to be used in the Naval ROTC Program (NROTC).

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

October 1, 2020

ADDITIONAL COST: There is no additional cost associated with this request.

PURPOSE:

A new subject code will allow the Naval ROTC unit to propose courses they will offer as part of their academic program in Naval Science and Leadership. It will also allow NROTC to schedule their courses according to University of Hawai'i at Mānoa processes and procedures.

BACKGROUND:

The Navy ROTC unit was established at UHM in August 2020. NROTC anticipates its first partial selection class of freshmen in Fall 2021, with its first major freshmen class in Fall 2022. Eventually, the program will attract between 150 and 200 students. It is expected that the ten basic Naval Science Courses would be prepared, scheduled and offer by Fall 2022.
