This proposal is for Windward CC to offer an ASC in general music. On the Windward side of the island, we have many excellent high school music programs, but there is no option for them at Windward to continue their music studies towards a certificate because all the music classes at the College are electives.

UII Maui has a ASC in Music Studies. Our certificate would be similar to theirs, and would consist of the same core subjects with the addition of piano.

The certificate requires 13 core credits and 12 elective credits, 6 of which must be performance credits, for a total of 25 credits.

iv. Description of demand and social value of the program

The windward side of the island of O'ahu has a number of high schools with bands and music programs. These programs are currently untapped by Windward CC. Without a certificate in General Music we have limited ability to recruit students within these high schools. As of right now, we can only offer that they can come and learn music from us and get elective credits. With a certificate, we will be able to go to these schools, explain our certificate offerings and show a music pathway for those students who have already committed quite a bit of time and energy to learn music at pre-college levels.

The social value of the program comes with the territory of music programs. The social value of the program comes with the territory of music programs. There are great opportunities for intergenerational knowledge transfer in our music program. Our students have had the opportunity to perform with treasured Hawaiian musicians and recording artists such as Cyril Pahinui, Palani Vaughan, Jerry Santos, Amy Hanaiali'i, Ledward Ka'apana, Dennis Kamakahi and many more. This has helped to connect our students to the culture of this place that they currently call home. It has also inspired many of them to pursue careers in music. Music is a great outlet for students to discover self-identity and as a means of expression for those students that has a platform for their voice and thoughts to be heard.

Having a certificate also positions us to be able to apply for funding, grants, and scholarships that will provide opportunities for Windward CC students. Right now, with no music certificate deliverables or outcomes, we are very limited in what funding the College qualifies for. Therefore, our requests for funding would probably be viewed as non-essential or extracurricular.

v. Description of resources needed, including budget, personnel, and facilities.

If none are required, how will existing facilities and equipment be utilized?

We would need to hire a minimum of one, possibly two music lecturers in order to offer the

classes needed so that students can graduate within a two-year time frame. As far as resources, budget, and facilities, we would be able to function within our current model.
