BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In accordance with Board of Regents' policy governing Academic Affairs, Section 5-1a, Kapi'olani Community College requests Board of Regents approval to terminate the Associate in Science Educational Paraprofessional with a Concentration in Deaf and Hard of Hearing and the Associate in Science Educational Paraprofessional with a Concentration in Special Education.

degree was developed at the expressed request of the DOE to address the needs of educational assistants in meeting the newly established standards associate with No Child Left Behind (NCLB). However, as the provisions for meeting NCLB requirements changed over time, there was increasingly less need to provide training for entry-level educational assistants.

As a result, the College elected to stop-out these two areas of concentration in the A.S. for Educational Paraprofessionals, effective Fall 2010. Faculty re-examined the curriculum and began exploring potential baccalaureate pathways for students whose career goal is to work in educational settings with children with special needs or children who are deaf or hard of hearing.

The baccalaureate pathway for students who are interested in Special Education leads to the University of Hawai'i at Manoa College of Education. Faculty have now developed articulation agreements for the two- and four-year curricula. This pathway is built on the foundation of an Associate in Arts in Liberal Arts degree, with the courses formerly included in the A.S. degree included as electives. No pathway exists within the University of Hawai'i system for students who wish to focus their baccalaureate studies on the needs of children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Thus, articulation agreements have been developed with a mainland institution (Lamar University, Texas).

No students will be negatively impacted by the termination of the Associate in Science Educational Paraprofessional with a Concentration in Deaf and Hard of Hearing and the Associate in Science Educational Paraprofessional with a Concentration in Special Education. All former majors have graduated or have been successfully integrated into the Associate in Arts degree program. One FTE faculty and lecturers who taught the courses for the Associate in Science degree will continue to teach the courses, which will now be incorporated into the Associate in Arts degree.
