### SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs approve the addition of a **Dual Preparation Blended Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education PK-3 Specialization** to the Bachelor of Education in Elementary Education. The proposal, approved by the COE Faculty Senate and Dean's Office, is a merger and modification of existing programs.

### RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2014

#### ADDITIONAL COST:

Dean Don Young agreed to fund one new early childhood/literacy faculty position dedicated primarily to the 2014 Blended ECE/ECSE program. Other staffing and resources for the program already are in place.

#### PURPOSE:

The purpose of the **Dual Preparation Blended Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education PK-3 Specialization** is to provide a statewide ECE teacher preparation program that leads to a Bachelor of Education degree with qualification for PK-3 licensure in general and special education in Hawai'i. Program graduates will be fully qualified to teach young children, with and without disabilities, ages 3-8. They will be especially well prepared to teach in inclusive early childhood settings.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Bachelor of Education in Elementary Education offers specializations in elementary education (K-6), dual preparation in elementary education (K-6) and early childhood education (PK-3), and dual preparation in elementary education (K-6) and special education (K-6). The College of Education requests to add a new blended specialization in early childhood education (PK-3) and early childhood special education (PK-3).

There is a significant need for teachers who are fully credentialed to serve children ages 3 through 8 in inclusive early childhood settings nationally and in Hawai'i. Highly qualified early childhood education inclusion teachers need to possess knowledge and performance competencies that are blended from the fields of general ECE and early childhood special education. Federal legislation has encouraged the development of blended general and special education teacher preparation programs, beginning most notably with the Dean's Grants in 1974. The Head Start program in Hawai'i currently serves 3,047children with 161 teachers and 160 Assistant Teachers. The Hawai'i Department of Education reported that they served 2,455 children ages 3-5 years with disabilities, and 3,339 children ages 6-8 with disabilities in the 2009-2010 school year. Although teachers are employed in these early childhood settings, many are not fully qualified as early childhood educators. This program will prepare graduates who are fully qualified to teach young children, with and without disabilities, ages 3-8, and especially well prepared to teach in inclusive early childhood settings.

### **ACTION RECOMMENDED:**

It is recommended that the Chancellor approve the addition of a **Dual Preparation Blended Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education PK-3 Specialization** to the Bachelor of Education in Elementary Education.
