#### **SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:**

It is requested that the Chancellor approve the request to change the name of the Graduate Certificate in Global Health and Population Studies to the Graduate Certificate in Global Health Protection and Security in the School of Public Health.

#### RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

To be effective upon the Chancellor's approval.

#### ADDITIONAL COST:

No additional costs are associated with this request.

#### **PURPOSE:**

The Graduate Certificate in Global Health and Population Studies, approved in 1975, now only attracts a few students as its focus on population has become unpopular over time. As a result of this assessment, the School of Public Health revised the program requirements, and included a focus on human security. Given the new focus, the School is requesting that the title of the certificate be changed to reflect the focus and to attract more students.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Board of Regents' Policy 5-1 (2) delegates to the President the authority to approve certificate programs. University of Hawai'i Executive Policy E5.205 further delegates this authority to the Chancellor.

The program was first established as an interdisciplinary Graduate Certificate in Population Studies, drawing faculty from the College of Social Sciences, the then UH

Rationale: The GHPS program has only attracted a handful of students over the past few years because the 'population' focus has become unpopular over time. On 08 Oct 2013, the Office of Graduate Education met and approved a change in requirements for this program. The most significant change was the inclusion of a course on human security. This memo describes a name change that focuses the certificate on protection and security aspects of global health that are very topical (see description overleaf). This change in coursework has already generated a significant amount of interest and the name change is essential for correctly labeling the certificate and attracting more enrolments.
