SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Vice-Chancellor approve changing one of the specialization names in the KRS MS from Physical Education/Adapted Physical Education to Physical Activity/Adapted Physical Activity. This change in the name of the specialization more accurately reflects content coverage across the lifespan rather than being limited to school-age populations. The Dean's Office and the COE Faculty Senate recommend this change.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Spring 2014

ADDITIONAL COST:

There is no additional cost (no change in faculty or program requirements).

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this request is to change one of the specialization names in the KRS MS from Physical Education/Adapted Physical Education to Physical Activity/Adapted Physical Activity.

BACKGROUND:

KRS offers three specializations in the MS degree: athletic training, physical education/adapted physical education, and rehabilitation counselor education. KRS faculty who advise and teach in the physical education/adapted physical education specialization cover content across the lifespan, rather than limiting the focus of the specialization to school-age populations. This request for a change in specialization name is based on careful evaluation of the curriculum, trends in the profession, student inquiries about physical activity beyond school-age individuals, and changing student interests. This change does not negatively affect current course offerings or resources in the department. The proposed change will help KRS attract a wider group of

prospective graduate students while still providing a source of professional development for school personnel.
