Change in degree and administrative home for the K-12 Physical Education

undergraduate licensure program

SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Chancellor approve the move of the administrative home of the undergraduate teacher licensure program in K-12 Physical Education from Secondary Education/Institute for Teacher Education (ITE) to the Department of Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science (KRS). It is also requested that the Chancellor approve changing the degree from a Bachelor of Education (BEd) in Secondary Education to a Bachelor of Science (BS) in Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science. The KRS Department currently offers a BS specialization in Health and Exercise Science, which is a non-teaching degree. The K-12 Physical Education specialization, which includes coursework in health education, would provide a second specialization in the BS degree. The KRS faculty members teach the methods, field experience, student teaching, and seminar courses required in the ITE BEd program. Moving the K-12 Physical Education specialization under the BS in KRS degree would not affect national accreditation recognition or teacher licensure. The Dean's Office and the COE Faculty Senate recommend this change.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

Fall 2014

ADDITIONAL COST:

There is no additional cost (no change in faculty or program requirements).

PURPOSE:

 Eliminate the Bachelor of Education (BEd) track in Physical Education Teacher Education from the Institute for Teacher Education/Secondary Education.

2. Move the Physical Education Teacher Education track to the existing Bachelor of Science (BS) degree in Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science.

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BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Board of Regents Policy, Chapter 3-2, adopted by the Board of Regents on October 19, 2006, and amended on May 19, 2011, the President is delegated the authority to establish, abolish, reorganize, reassign, or rename organizational units. Pursuant to UH Administrative Procedures Chapter A3.101, Section 3.b, dated March 2008, authority to approve organizational changes that are not subject to BOR approval...is delegated by the BOR to the President and by the President to each Vice President and Chancellor, provided that all organizational changes must be approved two supervisory levels above where the changes are proposed and may not be further delegated.

As part of the KRS Department's continued reorganization for effectiveness and efficiency, the faculty members recommend moving the K-12 Physical Education undergraduate teacher licensure track from the BEd in Secondary Education/ITE to the BS in Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science. The faculty and program requirements would remain the same. The BEd majors in K-12 Physical Education have indicated unanimous support for this change. Moving the degree to the BS in KRS allows:

- 1. Improved oversight and utilization of existing department resources with both programs housed administratively in KRS.
- 2. Clearer alignment of coursework to degree, since most of the coursework for the K-12 Physical Education track already is in KRS rather than ITE.
- 3. Shared content knowledge across both BS specializations (K-12 Physical Education and Health & Exercise Science).

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that the Chancellor move the administrative home of the undergraduate teacher licensure program in K-12 Physical Education from Secondary Education/Institute for Teacher Education (ITE) to the Department of Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science (KRS). In addition, it is recommended that the Chancellor change the degree from a Bachelor of Education (BEd) in Secondary Education to a Bachelor of Science (BS) in Kinesiology and Rehabilitation Science.
