SPECIFIC ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that admissions to the BA and BS in Zoology be stopped out for a period beginning with the approval of this request and continuing until July 1, 2018.

RECOMMENDED EFFECTIVE DATE:

It is requested that the stop-out be effective upon approval of this request and continue until July 1, 2018.

ADDITIONAL COST:

No additional cost.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this action is to prepare for the termination of the BA and BS degrees in Zoology by stopping admissions to the degree programs but allowing existing students to complete their degrees. This is pursuant to the previously approved merger of the Zoology Department with the Biology Department to create a new Department of Biology.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Under Board of Regents policy Chapter 5: ACADEMIC AFFAIRS, Section 5-1: <u>Instructional Programs</u>, Paragraph f, an admission stop-out to a program for more than two years is delegated to the President.

All of the biological sciences are changing and becoming much more integrated. Well-established principles taught in zoology courses are equally valid for courses in the other biological sciences. We now speak of biogeography, for example, rather than zoogeography. When we teach genetics we use biological examples from bacteria to humans. In short, the separation of zoology from biology is becoming less important from a disciplinary perspective, and the courses that are required of students in the Biology and Zoology degree programs are quite similar. In recognition of these changes in the field, a proposal to combine the Department of Zoology with the Department of Biology was developed and submitted to the Mānoa Chancellor.

The reorganization merging the Zoology Department with the Biology Department to create a new Department of Biology was approved on May 29, 2011. The merger proposal included the plan to eliminate undergraduate degrees in Zoology (but retain the MS and PhD in Zoology). This request is the necessary first step to carry out the plan in an orderly manner. The stop-out period has been selected to ensure that present students in the Zoology BA and BS degree programs will be able to complete their degrees (or otherwise leave the program) before the elimination of the degrees. At present there are 100 students in the Zoology BA and BS programs (37 freshmen, 11 sophomores, 23 juniors and 29 seniors).

In surveys conducted during the consideration of the merger it was found that some undergraduates would still like a Zoology degree; this will be addressed by offering biological science degrees with specializations in zoological fields. All Zoology course alphas will be converted to Biology alphas and conflicts will be resolved through the Biology Curriculum Committee. Course equivalencies and common course numbering will be addressed by the same committee.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

It is recommended that admissions to the BA and BS in Zoology be stopped-out for a period beginning with the approval of this request and continuing until July 1, 2018.

d) do not have significant programmatic impact on the University may be approved under delegated authority by the Chancellor for reorganizations that are two (2) supervisory levels below (APM A3.101, Section 3b).
