Background Information: Leeward is creating a new <u>concentration</u> program code for the Alternative Certificate for CTE Licensure. Program requires a Baccalaureate or Associate degree for admission. The course work level is all undergraduate classes. Campus is requesting level to be <u>Post-Baccalaureate</u>. No major code was indicated by the campus.

Questions/Concerns:

- 1. Are community colleges allowed to have a Post-Baccalaureate (PB) level? Note, the only campus that offers PB level is UH Hilo; and, only Hilo and Manoa offer Graduate level. And if they are, should this be considered PB since a student can be admitted with an Associate too?
- 2. Does the concentration need to be attached to a major code?
